

All of the merchants at Urban Air Market are independent artists and designers who are committed to sustainability. This innovative marketplace allows conscious consumers to buy one of a kind, quality products directly from the artisans themselves, giving them a memorable shopping experience.

In addition to shopping outdoors in our neighborhood, shoppers can enjoy acoustic performances by local musicians, kick up their feet in the relaxation lounge hosted by BakPocket Products, find food trucks at the Proxy, and sip on SF's finest coffee from local roasting house, Blue Bottle Coffee.

"As more restaurants have gotten on board with using handmade tableware, my business has been steadily growing and we are quickly outgrowing our Hayes Valley studio. This grant will really help me to grow my business and allow me to keep a steady and talented crew of workers on my team. With hopes of a bigger space in the future I really feel like this grant is getting us one step closer."

This grant contest offers an opportunity for small businesses to share their inspirational stories and achieve recognition while also rallying support from the local community to grow their businesses.
