Neighborhood Emergency Response Training for Western Addition Begins Jan. 18th

Teighborhood Emergency Response Team (NERT) is a free training program for individuals, neighborhood groups, and community-based organizations in San Francisco. Through the program, individuals will learn the basics of personal preparedness and prevention. Classes will be held one night a week for 6 weeks beginning Wednesday, January 18th. Class topics include risk awareness, sisaster supplies, personal and family Membership Levels: disaster planning, light search and rescue, disaster medicine, terrorism awareness, disaster pre-planning. Public Safety Update

t the December 5 Public Safety Meeting Northern Police Station provided some good 🗥 news on several fronts. In November 8 new officers from the recently graduated 🛛 Small Non-Profit \$50 police academy were added to Northern Station. In December 10 more were added. That is a 15% increase in the number of officers assigned to Northern Station. For several weeks in late November and early December there was a spike in street robberies including muggings in the Northern Police District. On December 4 there were 3-4 of these crimes within blocks of Northern Station. The police were able to identify the suspect car and stopped it and arrested several suspects. The car was filled with stolen goods. Good work Northern Station in stopping some of these serial robbers.
