Silent Disco Block Party Recap



We kicked-off the 2017 Silent Disco Block Party Series, presented by HVNA and ZERO dB Global, a local events and audio entertainment production company. For those unversed in the concept, begs the question: "What is Silent Disco"? In layman's terms, it's music entertainment provided without amplified sound, using wireless headphones and long range transmitters. The Headphones have 3 audio channels, LED lights - red, blue and green, each color visually representing a channel and individual controls for power, volume and channel selection. The RF Wireless Transmitter has the power to stream music to thousands of headphones with a range of 1000 - 1300 ft. To compare: a Bluetooth Transmitter can connect with 1-2 headsets and has a short range of 30-50 ft.

The Block Party, by all measures was a Hit. The event's broad appeal resulted in a turnout of about 160, culturally diverse people, ranging in age that spanned five generations, from sweet 16 to budding 75 years' young. The atmosphere on Hayes the night of the party was not the usual. It was brimming with energy & excitement. There's no mistaking the partygoers from the non-party folks by the brightly lit headphones on their heads but aside from that, they exuded fun, were energetic, cheerful and in a constant state of rhythmic motion. The Silent Disco crowd forged a strong comradery as they recognized an energy and excitement in themselves, shared among themselves; giving each other high fives in the middle of the crosswalk, acknowledging one another with a wave and endorsing one's music channel with a thumbs up.

Kudos to the DJs Sat night, they streamed different genres of music to the 3 channels, giving partygoers a fresh set of song choices all through the night. We had two DJ stations at Patricia's Green and a third at Sugar Lounge, a sponsor bar that concocted a drink special for Silent Disco attendees. With the combination of good music, awesome DJ and drink special, Sugar Lounge was sardine packed. Meehey, the Owner and General Manager of Sugar Lounge summed it best: "We've never been busier than that night. People had to wait for drinks but they were all having a good time, they didn't mind. They were dancing inside and outside the bar. It was wonderful. Thank you so much."
