Ages Valley Art Works (HVAW) is a community creation space that has been made possible by the partnership of the Hayes Valley Neighborhood Association and Haight Street Art Center. While bringing public art to the neighborhood - Hayes Valley Art Works has also activated and helped to maintain public vacant space in neighborhood. Their mission is to have the community to come together to discuss, learn, teach, share and express artistic vision for the betterment of the neighborhood. This project allows artists to create and display original pieces, curate exhibits, performances, community events and unique gathering spaces on a vacant lot with a long history.

After over a year at Parcel O at Fell St. & Laguna St. (one of the many lots leftover from the removal of the Central Freeway), Hayes Valley Art Works will relocate to Parcel S at Page St. and Octavia Blvd. (also leftover from the removal of the Central Freeway).

You'll also notice our Hayes Valley Merchants Insert, promoting our merchant members. Please support our local merchants as much as possible. As you may know, we have in place a ban on chain stores in our merchant district. HVNA helped define what "local" means to our city.

We are focused on efforts to restore the plantings and maintain the presentation along Octavia Boulevard, the Homelessness Task Force is organizing efforts to improve quality of life for all neighbors, new affordable housing is coming to Hayes Valley at Parcel O, and new entertainment activities are on the way for all to enjoy and support. If you have ideas, please contact the one of our committees.

Road construction activity has increased. The long-awaited sewer/water system replacement project has finally started on Hayes Street, between Laguna and Webster. Later, the work will begin in our commercial district, and it will be a major disruption for our merchants. We are giving as much notice and trying to prepare them for the business barriers and street closures that accompany this important work. Along with the underground work, SFMTA will install pedestrian safety bulbouts at the corners of Laguna and Buchanan Streets after the work is

completed. The bulbouts are a part of a greater effort to calm traffic and keep pedestrians safe in our neighborhood.


SFMTA will be rolling out a Page Street project to reduce traffic congestion there. The real issue is traffic apps continue to push traffic to small side streets. The owners of the apps must take responsibility for directing traffic to small side streets incapable of handling the traffic. Change the apps to protect small streets! Driving in Hayes Valley with streets nearly always at capacity requires patience. Honking doesn't help and is against the law unless an emergency. While the traffic leaving the city on Octavia Blvd is about the same as before the freeway came down, the apps now direct traffic off Oak Street to the side streets of Page and Haight. Encourage everyone you know to stay on Oak Street when leaving the city via Octavia. It's designed to handle the traffic. They'll arrive at their destination just fine.


The Hayes Valley Playground cleanup had a fantastic team of valued volunteers also - with the cute award going to our regular volunteer Maura's niece ...redheads rock!






# Mourning Doves Nesting in Hayes Valley

# Business Crime Covered at May 1<sup>st</sup> Public Safety Meeting: More Communication Needed

One of the most important things coming from the Public Safety Meeting on May 1<sup>st</sup> was still the need to get information to businesses about how to fight crime. Furlishous Wyatt, the Business Specialist for SF SAFE, provided some good tips about how to prevent crime and what to do and who to call when it happens. Crime against businesses in Hayes Valley include vandalism, robbery and burglary, shoplifting and homeless issues. Some of the most vulnerable are fashion and apparel stores. One business owner in attendance said her store has been hit almost 10 times in the last few years.

Some tips include the benefits of installing cameras at a business. It was discussed the best way to position the camera. Cameras make it easier to identify when a crime happened and who carried it out. Northern Station offered to come to the business a few weeks after the camera is installed to make sure it is positioned correctly. Cameras are less expensive and easier to get then most people think. Most of the crime against businesses are committed by repeat offenders. If you can get a good picture of the suspect maybe you can stop them from another crime Another discussion was the position of the metal gates at a business---In front of the window or behind the glass. Northern Station has a good flyer about identifying suspects.

Business crime can also occur in the form of vandalism. Several businesses were subject to this type of crime over the recent Memorial Day weekend (see photos at right).

With all the good information provided there is still a need to reach out to more businesses in Hayes Valley. Maybe the best way is to organize by the block and have a meeting on that block at a better time for business owners. Most of SF SAFE work is free and the best way to get Furlishous Wyatt to provide his good insight is to have a block or neighborhood meeting like the May 1st meeting. There is still a need to find the best ways to prevent crimes against businesses in Hayes Valley.
